Scholarship Information

The UAFS Alumni Association Scholarship is offered to non-degree –holding students with a family connection to a graduate of UAFS, Westark, or Fort Smith Junior College. The scholarship is open to freshman level or above students in any major who meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must have one of the following relationships with an alumnus:
(a.) Parent of an alumnus (b.) Child of an alumnus (c.) Spouse of an alumnus (d.) Sibling of an alumnus
- Applicants must be pursuing a certificate or degree program at University of Arkansas-Fort Smith
- Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) credit hours
- Applicants must have and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75
- Applicants authorizes UAFS and the UAFS Foundation to publish applicant's photo and story

At least one Alumni Association Scholarship will be awarded each academic year. The amount of each award will depend on the availability of funds. Awards are applied to the student's account each Fall and Spring semester and may be used to pay tuition, fees, books, supplies, housing, and meal plans. The award may continue for up to eight (8) semesters, subject to fund availability. Past recipients may reapply. Submitted applications will be verified by the Alumni Office and sent to the Financial Aid Office for review by the scholarship committee.
